



# We have funding available **NOW** for QCF qualifications



The QCF funding level for 2017/18 is £15.00 per credit. This has been set at a maximum of 60. To give you an idea of how much funding you could be awarded per qualification, and how much of this you can claim in each financial year, please see the table below.
