We're busy preparing for Hypo Awareness Week 2019. The annual campaign to raise awareness of hypoglycaemia in the UK and Ireland by educating healthcare professionals will take place between September 30 and October 6.

The Hypo Awareness Week Excellence Award will be part of the QiC Diabetes awards programme, with the winner due to be announced at the awards ceremony which takes place on Thursday, October 17.

Again, the core of the campaign will focus on secondary care but we will also be looking to work with primary care and care provider colleagues to widen the campaign and get the important message about hypo awareness out into the community.
