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Framed around the 'A Covid-19 Response action – Diabetes Management in Care Homes'<sup>1</sup> guidance, this new workshop has been developed collaboratively by Lynne Reedman from DUET diabetes and Professor Alan Sinclair from the foundation of Diabetes Research in Older People (fDROP) and Kings College, London.

Managing the acutely unwell older person who has diabetes provides many challenges. During this workshop Professor Sinclair will share some of the lessons learnt as a result of the coronavirus pandemic combined with many years of experience and research covering diabetes care for older people.

**The aims of this new workshop are to:**

- increase skills and confidence within the care sector by providing the knowledge and tools with which to appropriately care for the acutely unwell older resident living with diabetes
- minimise morbidity and mortality from acute illness (such as Covid-19) in the older adult living with diabetes; maintain or even improve quality of life (QoL).
